The emperor Jahangir struck a remarkable series of figural type rupees and mohurs, unprecedented for a Muslim prince. Besides extremely rare portrait pieces, he instituted a series of Zodiactal types, each one to be struck in the corresponding month. The obverse dies were reused from year to year, new dated reverses being produced for each subsequent issue. Whereas mohurs were issued for every month, only five types of Zodiactal rupees were issued at Ahmadabad mint, a selected few similar types were struck at Agra, Fathpur and Kashmir mints all are rarer than the Ahmadabad issues. In addition, special specimen strikes were apparently produced for important visitors to the Mogul court, each receiving a coin with his Zodiac symbol.
