This is the coin type that Andrews should have illustrated in his book for Governor King's proclamation of 1800, rather than an 1808 pagoda for Madras that was illustrated. Crellin uses the coin type as an illustration on his cover of his book "The Coinage of Colonial Australia, Governor King's Proclamation of 1800". He devotes a chapter to this coin type (pp.63-69).

- Sale 67 (lot 1248) previously offered in Sothebys sale November 1997 in London, said to have come from Paris a few years earlier.
- 6. The present coin in this sale obtained from England by B.Winsor ten years ago.
