Bill of Exchange, G.Blaxcell, handwritten, Sydney, July 13th 1812, two hundred and fifty pounds, payable to Captain Joseph James, on or before 24th September 1812. Accompanied by a printed form of a notice of protest printed by George Howe, Sydney, 1813, signed by Ellis Bent, Judge Advocate of the Territory of New South Wales, showing that Blaxcell had not paid by 16th August 1813. *Stained on right and left hand side, good fine and extremely rare.* (2)

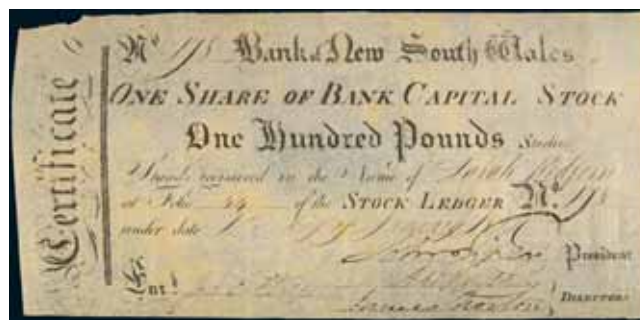

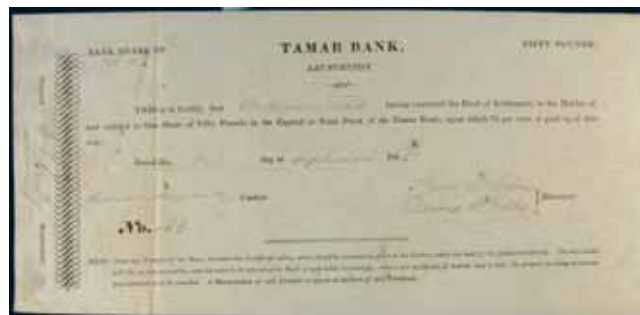

An extremely rare example of this early bank, as no banknotes are known to have survived. *Two folds, extremely fine and extremely rare.*

The Tamar Bank opened for business on January 1st 1835 and ceased operation on 30th April 1838, when it was absorbed by the Union Bank of Australia, re-opening the next day as the first branch of this newly formed bank. Lewis Gilles remained as manager of the Union Bank branch. The Union Bank merged with the Bank of Australasia in 1951 to form the A.N.Z. Bank Ltd. A further merger with the E.S. & A. in 1970 resulted in the ANZ Banking Group Ltd.

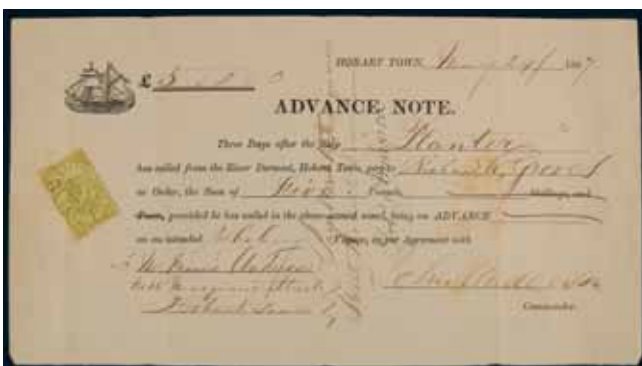

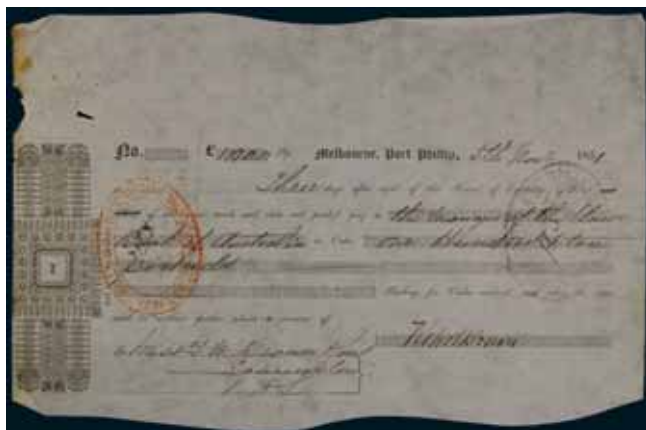

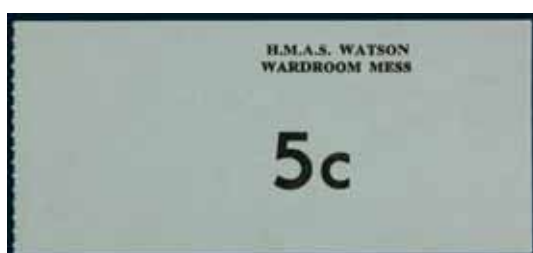
