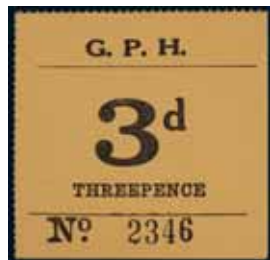
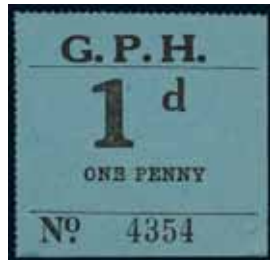

The sixth issue one pound purportedly ceased being issued in 1916. 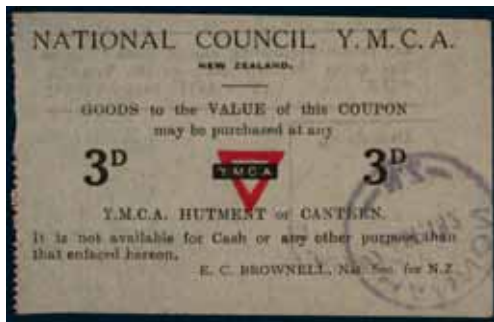

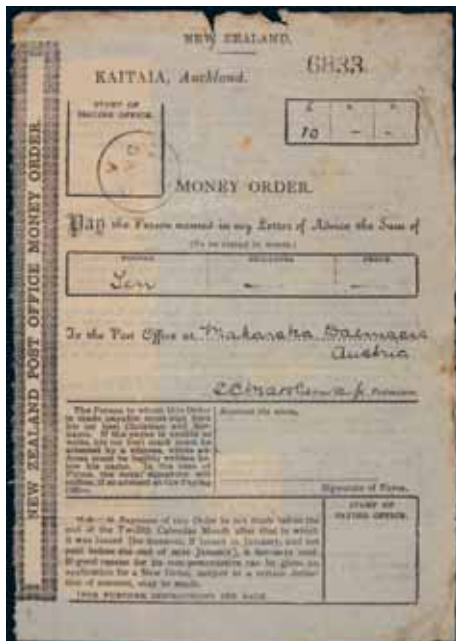
