Edward IV died on April 9, 1483 and the mint mark continued through the reign of Edward V and the start of the reign of Richard III. Reed's indenture contract ended 20th July 1483 which saw his replacement Robert Brackenbury with his boar's head mintmark. Richard III accession took place on June 26th 1483. Clearly the sun and rose mintmark covers the end of Edward IV and all the reign of Edward V.
